2016 - 2017 Hospital Salary & Benefits Report

The hourly rate of Social Workers (MSWs) in hospitals increased 1.94% in 2016, according to the **2016-2017 Hospital Salary & Benefits Report**, just published by **Hospital & Healthcare Compensation Service (HCS)**. Comparatively, the hourly rate of BSWs increased 1.23%.

The hourly rates for MSWs ranged from an average of \$33.41 in hospitals with less than 200 beds; \$33.76 in hospitals with 200-499 beds; and an average of \$33.69 for those with 500 beds or greater.

BSWs received an hourly average rate of \$30.21 in for-profit hospitals compared to an average of \$24.31 in not-for-profit hospitals.

- Data reported by bed-size, profit type, revenue, region, and state
- Percentile reported: 10th, 25th, 50th, 75th, 90th and average
